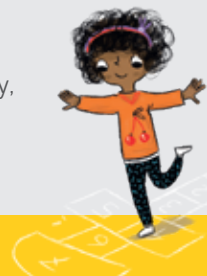
Ee-yore! Ee-yore! Welcome to the town's market. Each week you can come here to buy the healthiest vegetables, unique handicrafts and hearty local produce.
