My First Polish-English Encyclopaedia with Flaps

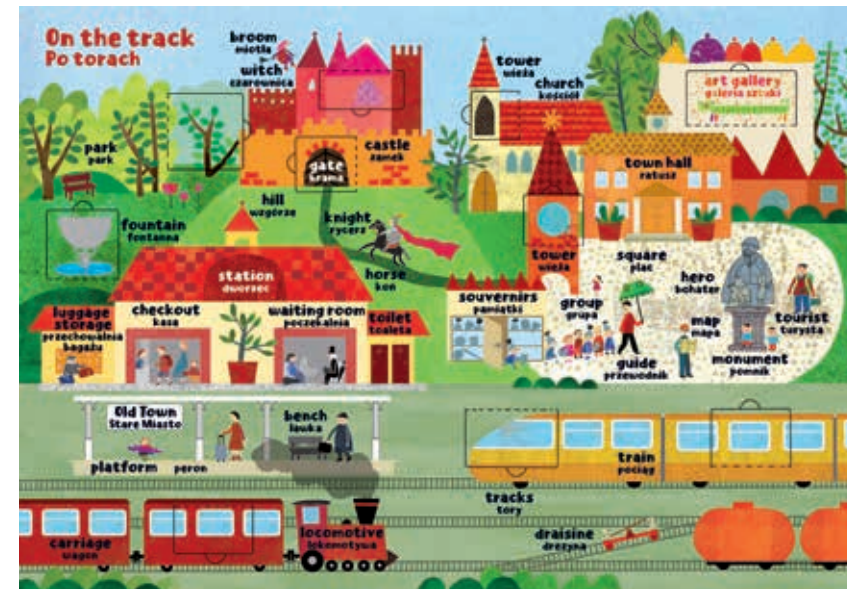
is an educational series that teaches our youngest readers about the world, and about English words.

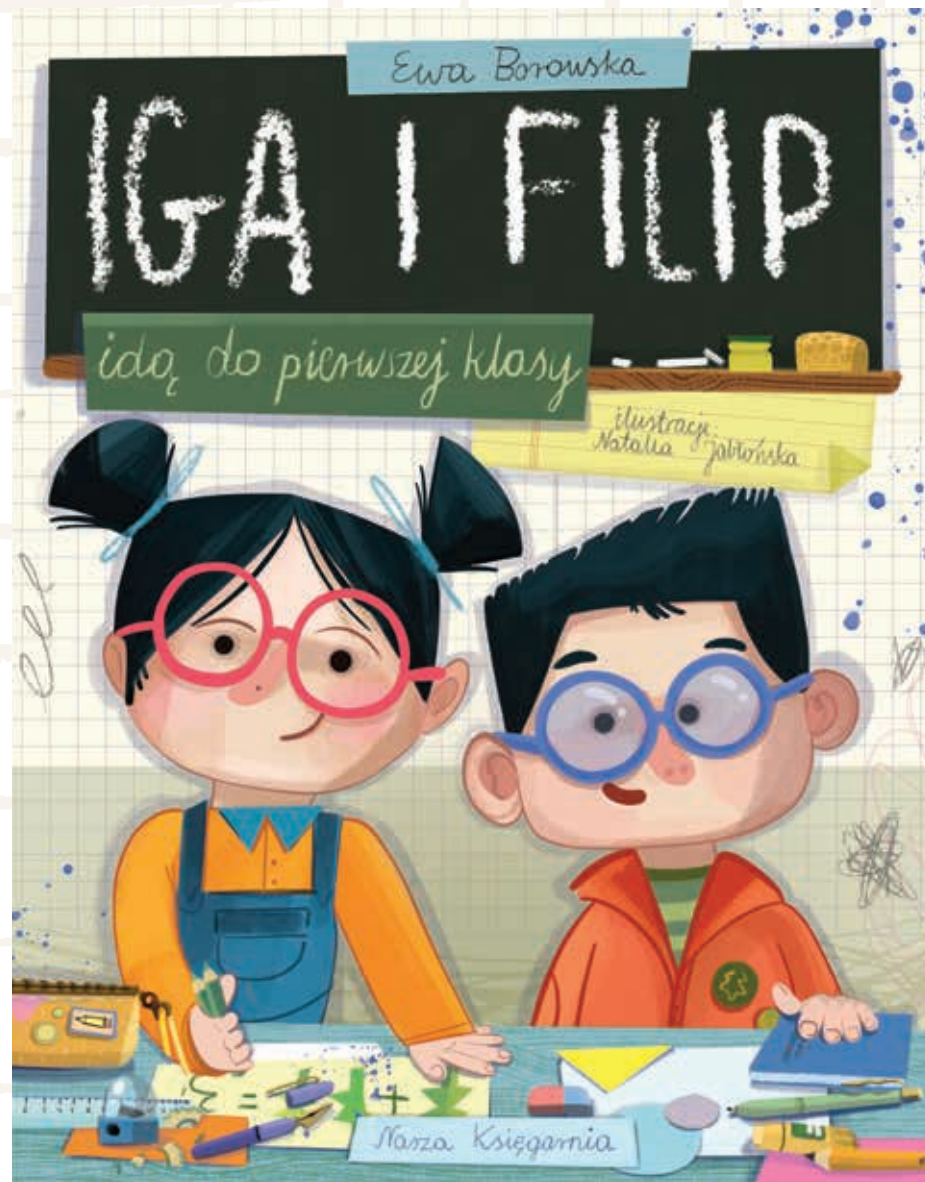
Isla and Philip Start School

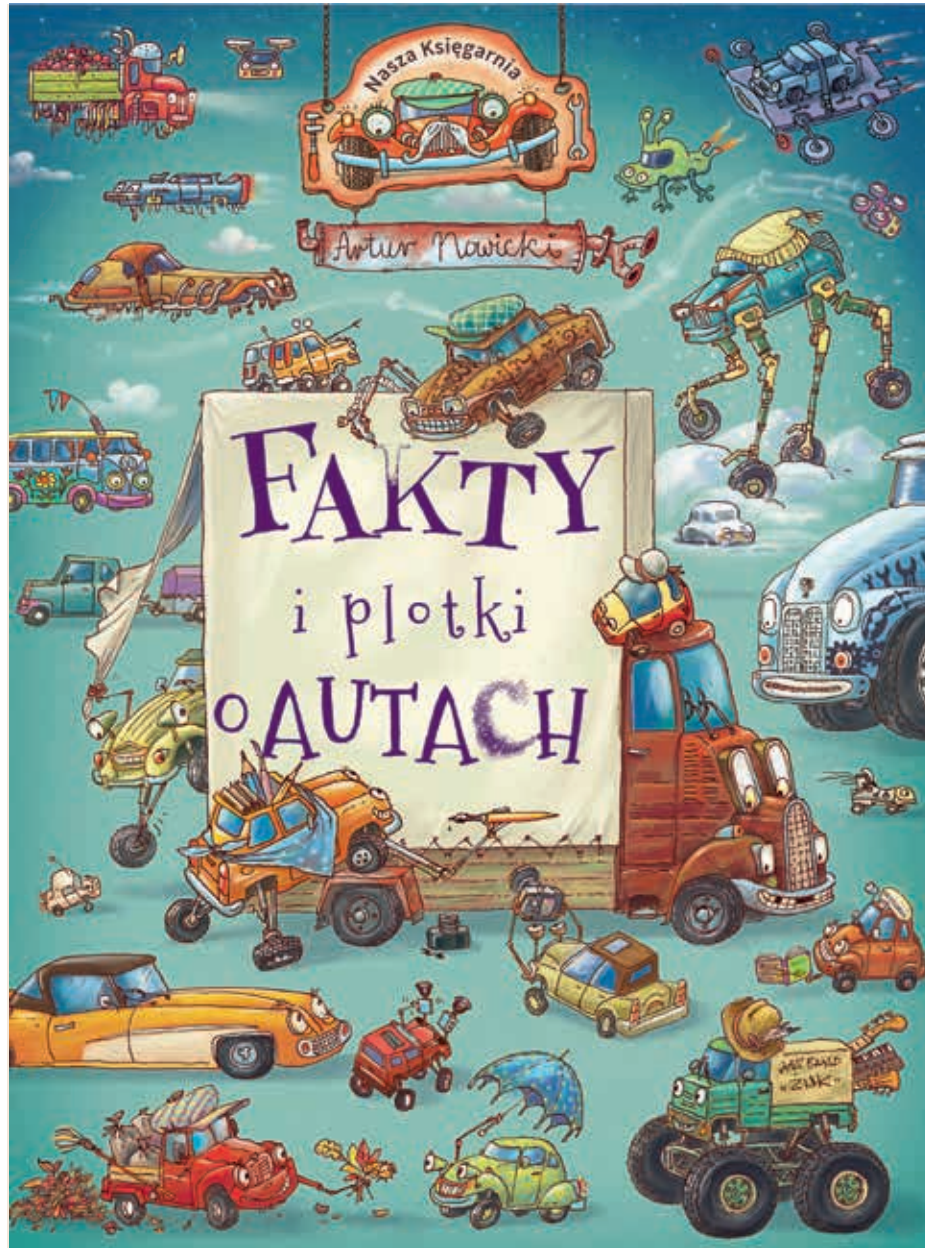
Facts and Rumours about Cars

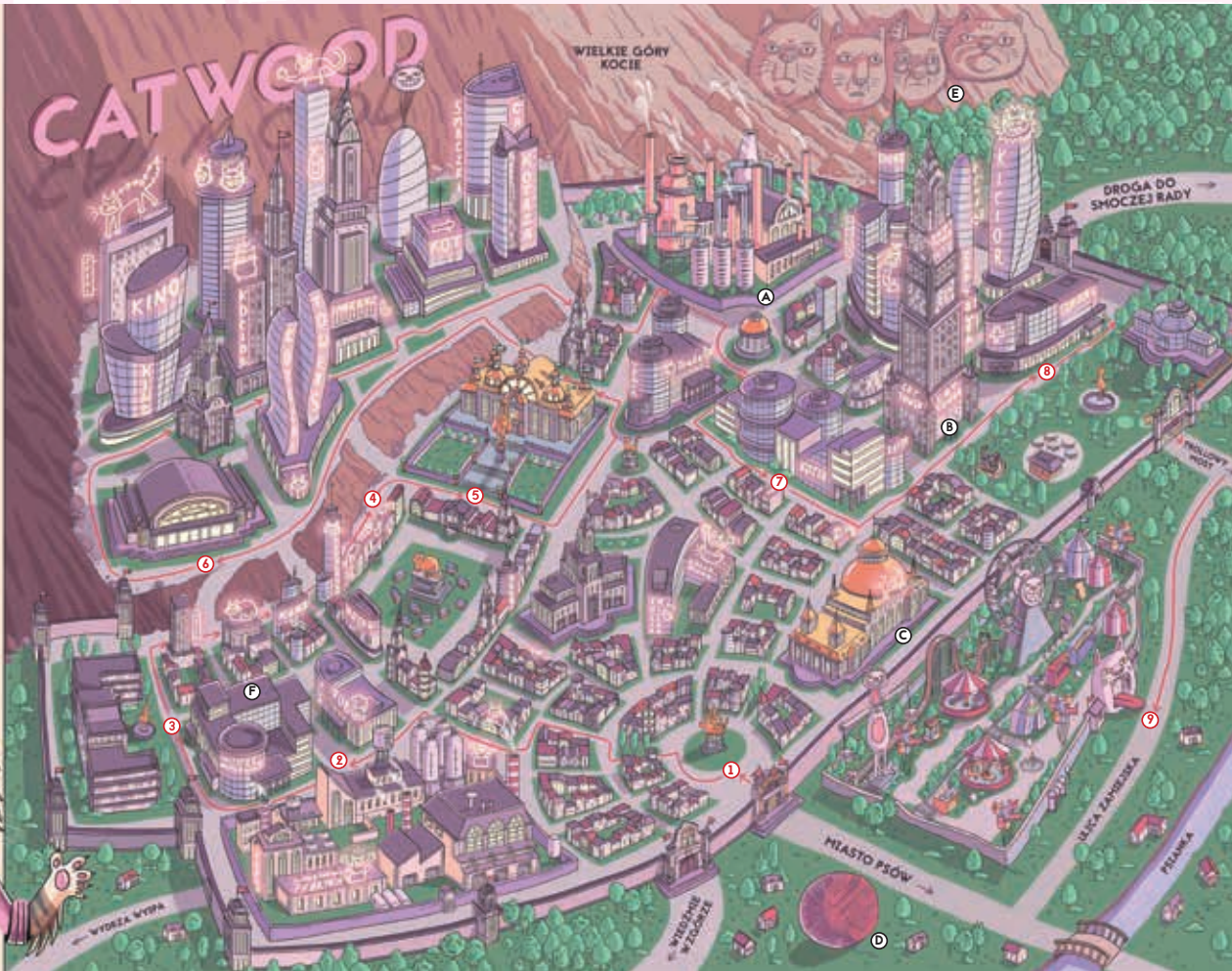

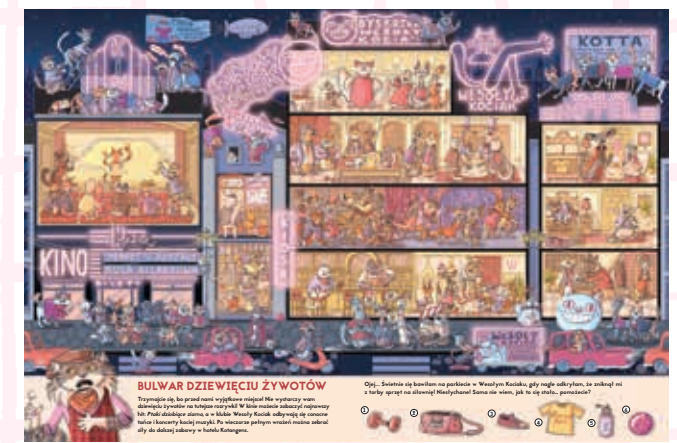

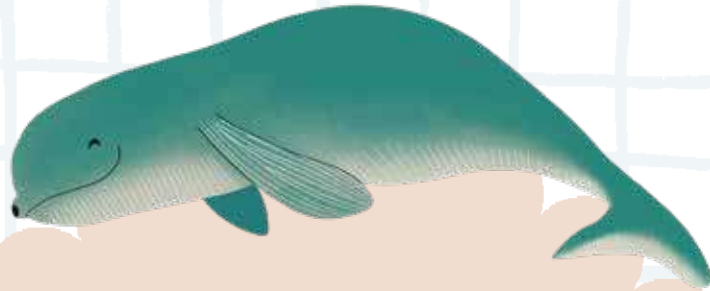
